A little tour of Waterville, before we go to lunch overlooking the Atlantic. You will finish with a view of Killarney from

Sunday, July 15 Killarney is part of a National Park, so you have a free day here to relax and

shop.

Monday, July 18 This morning we travel to Cong to see where the John Wayne movie, *The Quiet*

Man, was filmed. In Connemara we visit one of the prettiest sites in the world,

Kylemore Abbey with its fantastic gardens.

Tuesday, July 19 Travel to Belfast in Northern Ireland to see why the two Irelands exist. Learn
