- Saturday, June 29 Fly out of the United States
- Sunday, June 30 Arrive in Dublin and be transferred to Camden Court Hotel.
- Monday, July 1 Tour of Dublin and St. Patrick's Cathedral with our local guide, Dinner at the Merry Ploughboys, including music and Irish dancing.
- Tuesday, July 2 Travel to Belfast in Northern Ireland to see why the two Irelands exist. Learn the history of the divisions between the Protestants and Catholics and see the walls that separate them. Visit the famous Titanic Museum,
- Wednesday, July 3 Today we leave early for our visit to the oldest distillery in the world, Bushmills. In the afternoon you will be able to visit and see with your own eyes the Giant's Causeway.
- Thursday, July 4 Travel across the country of Ireland to visit a sheep farm and see how thatched roofs protect their cottages. We will be staying the night in Galway, a beautiful college town with a lot of music and charm.
- Friday, July 5 Leave in the afternoon to visit the world's famous Cliffs of Moher and the area known as The Burren. Tonight, is a special treat as we get to eat dinner at a Medieval Castle.
- Saturday, July 6 This morning we travel to Cong to see where the John Wayne movie, *The Quiet Man*, was filmed. Special treat today in Connemara as we visit one of the prettiest sites in the world, Kylemore Abbey with its fantastic gardens.
- Sunday, July 7 Today we travel to the scenic mountains and peninsulas of Ireland. Our first stop is Adare, where you will see the manor and the thatched-roof homes of the community. The second stop is for lunch in the town of Dingle, before going on to see the world-famous Sleah Head Drive. Dinner tonight at our hotel in Killarney.
- Monday, July 8 Today we tour the other peninsula, The Ring of Kerry. Our first stop is the picturesque Muckross House with its outstanding view of the countryside. We then stop for an Irish coffee and the Red Fox Inn, before going on to check to see how peat was made over the years. A little tour of Waterville, before we go to lunch overlooking the Atlantic. You will finish with a view of Killarney from Ladies View.
- Tuesday, July 9 A free day to enjoy the National Park of Killarney, maybe some bike riding, golf, horseback riding, cruising the lake or just shopping for some final things to take home. We will also do the jaunting carts through the park this day.
- Wednesday, July 10 As we travel back to Dublin we will make one last stop at Waterford to see the glass-making factory. Rather than letting the factory die the

workers bought into it and it is now a highly profitable endeavor and a great tour. Check into our hotel at the airport.
