- Galway: Kylemore Abbey, Connemara National Park, The Cliffs of Moher, North Atlantic Sheepdog Demonstration, Dinner and show at medieval castle
- Killarney: Tour of the Dingle Peninsula, the Famous Ring of Kerry, ride jaunting carts through Killarney National Park, tour the Midleton Distillery and visit the National Stud & Gardens

Tentative Itinerary:

June 16th - Fly out of the United States to Dublin, Ireland.

June 17th - Arrive in Dublin, a Gonzalo Tours host will meet you and provide transportation to the hotel. There will be a meeting in the evening.

June 18th - Tour of Kilmainham Gaol Museum, St. Patrick's Cathedral and Dublin. Tonight, dinner and a show will be at the Merry Ploughboys Pub.

June 19th - Depart for Northern Ireland and Belfast.

The history will be explained so that you understand why the Protestant and Catholics live in separate areas and you will tour both areas. The afternoon will be spent at the Titanic Museum.

June 20th - We head to the tip of the island to one of the top wonders of the world, Giant's Causeway. Afternoon excursion to Stormont Castle with a tour of Belfast.

June 21st – Across the island we go towards the college town of Galway. We will stop at the North Atlantic Sheepdog headquarters where they will demonstrate how the sheep dogs control their flock.

June 22nd - Today travel through Connemara National Park. In this area we will visit the picturesque Kylemore Abbey and its gardens.

June 23rd - This afternoon we are off to the world-famous Cliffs of Moher. In the evening, we will enjoy a dinner and show at the medieval castle where you will enjoy dinner and a show.

June 24th - We head to the Dingle Peninsula, but not before making a stop at the beautiful little town of thatched roofs, Adare. On to Dingle to see the beauty along the famous Sleat Head Drive. Dinner at our hotel tonight in Killarney.

June 25th - Today we start our free day with a tour of Killarney National Park on jaunting carts. The rest of the day is yours, you can shop, venture into the many pubs, bicycle ride, hike, play golf, you choose, it's your day!

June 26th - Today we start with a brief visit to the Muckross House and its beautiful location on Killarney Lake. Next, we jump on the Ring of Kerry, with our first stop at the Red Fox Inn to enjoy traditional Irish coffee. The Ring is the number one scenic drive in Ireland, as you will see. We will stop for lunch at a scenic overlook restaurant.

June 27th – On our way back to Dublin we will make a few stops. The first will be at the Midleton Distillery for a tour and a tasting as well as time for lunch. The second stop will be to tour the Irish National Stud & Gardens. We will end the day at the airport hotel.

June 28th – Shuttles run regularly to the airport for you trip back to the U.S.
