- Cinque Terra tour by boat with stops in quaint villages for shopping and snacking

- Lake Maggiore: Tour the island, enjoy dinner at Isola Pescatore, Tour of Isola Bella Island and Gardens
- Verona: Romeo and Juliet Experience, enjoy this quaint Italian city.
- Venice: Tour of the City of Venice, St. Mark's Square, Murano Glass Factory, and enjoy a gondola ride

Level of Walking: Difficult, especially in Rome and Florence as we cover a lot of these cities by foot.

Tentative Itinerary:

May 12th – Fly out of United States to Rome's Fiumicino Airport in Rome

May 13th – Arrive in Rome, a host will meet you and get you to your hotel. There will be a meeting in the evening to provide information and you can meet your hosts, guide and other guests.

May 14th - Today we enjoy the magic of the Vatican City. We will tour the Vatican Museum and the Sistine Chapel. Dinner tonight at a special restaurant in the City of Rome.

May 15th - We finish up our tour of Rome with a special visit to St. Peter's Basilica, the Colosseum, Trevi Fountain, the Pantheon and the Piazza Navona.

May 16th - We head toward the city of Florence in Tuscany. On the way we will stop at Assisi to see the famous St. Francis Basilica. From there we travel to Montecatini, an old spa town near Florence. The hotel in Montecatini will be our base of operation for the next four nights. Dinner at the hotel tonight.

May 17th – Today we go to Cinque Terra to see some of the most rugged coast line in Italy and its beautiful towns along the coast. We go by boat so that we can see the coast and experience the special feeling of Cinque Terra.

May 18th – Today we will enjoy Florence. We will visit and tour the Accademia with the Statue of David, visit Ponte Vecchio and the Duomo. As you travel through the streets of this beautiful city with a local guide, you will feel the history unfold.

May 19th – The City of Pisa is where we will start in the late morning. We will see the beautiful Duomo and of course the famous "Leaning Tower." Dinner tonight is special, as we will visit a Winery and Olive Oil Factory with great music and beautiful landscape.

May 20th – Today we travel to the Lakes District of Northern Italy. We will be staying at the Regina Palace Hotel on Lake Stresa. Once checked in, we will head to our boat to take us to Isola dei Pescatori, where we will have a fabulous dinner on the island overlooking this beautiful lake.

May 21st - Tour of Isola Bella and the Gardens located on an island in Lake Maggiore. Free time in the afternoon to explore Stresa.

May 22nd – Travel to Verona and explore the area that made Romeo and Juliet famous. Have lunch before heading to our hotel in Venice. Dinner at the hotel tonight.

May 23rd – Take the train into Venice and then a boat to St. Mark's Square. You will tour the city with a guide which will include St. Mark's Square and the Murano Glass Factory. The day will conclude with a ride in a famous gondola on a Venice canal. Dinner at the hotel tonight.

May 24th – Transfer to the airport for our flights back home.
