Tentative Itinerary:

May 3rd – Fly out of the United States and fly to Edinburgh, Scotland.

May 4th – Arrive in Edinburgh and a Gonzalo Tours host will meet you and get you transferred to our hotel in the Grassmarket area. The hotel is located right under the Edinburgh Castle. There will be a meeting tonight to go over details of the trip.

May 5th – Tour of Edinburgh including the Holyrood Palace with our local guide. Tonight, there will be dinner and show at the Spirit of Scotland Restaurant. Enjoy the music, dancing and learn the history of the country.

May 6th - We travel to Stirling and learn the history of Braveheart and the Scottish fight against the English. We will also do a tour of Glasgow in the afternoon.

May 7th – Today we travel to St. Andrews, the home of the British Open Golf Tournament. We'll visit this historic golf course and then take a tour of the city before heading north to Aberdeen where we will stay for the next two nights.

May 8th – We'll call this Whiskey Day as we will see how they brew their whiskey at the Cardhu Distillery. Also, fascinating is how they make their barrels at Speyside Cooperage for all the local distilleries.

May 9th – Today we head for the northern coast and the beautiful City of Inverness which is surrounded by water. Our first stop is Balmoral Castle as we cross the highlands. This is the summer residence of the English royalty.

May 10th – Today we are heading to Urquhart Castle where we will take a cruise in the afternoon and have an opportunity to search for the famous monster of Loch Ness.

May 11th – Today we visit Cawdor Castle, the famous castle known for MacBeth. We will also be exploring Culloden, where the Scottish had one of their most famous battles.

May 12th – Explore the Dunrobin Castle & Gardens and see a falconry presentation. The afternoon will be yours to explore the town of Inverness.

May 13th – We head south today, through the Scottish Highlands where we will see places like Loch Lomond, Fort William and the Caledonian Canal. This will be a scenic drive of all the glens and valleys. Our final destination will be our hotel in Edinburgh.

May 14th – Transfer to our flights back home to the United States.
