### **Tentative Itinerary:**

June 3<sup>rd</sup> – Tuesday – Depart from the United States to the Marco Polo Airport in Venice, Italy.

June 4<sup>th</sup> – Wednesday – Arrive in Venice, a host will meet you and get you to your hotel. There will be a meeting in the evening to provide information and you can meet your hosts and guide.

June 5<sup>th</sup> – Thursday – Take the train into Venice and then a boat to St. Mark's Square. You will tour the city with a guide which will include St. Mark's Square and the Murano Glass Factory. The day will conclude with a ride in a world famous gondola on a Venice canal.

June 6<sup>th</sup> – Friday – Leave Venice and head to Ljubljana to begin our tour of the beautiful country of Slovenia. Our first tour will be of the awesome caves of Postojna followed by the famous Predjama Castle. We will stay at the Intercontinental Hotel in Ljubljana.

June 7<sup>th</sup> – Saturday – A local guide will take us on a walking tour of the beautiful city of Ljubljana and then to Lake Bled. At Lake Bled we will enjoy a boat tour which will take us to visit the beautiful church and then “row” over to the former leader of Yugoslavia’s residence.

June 8<sup>th</sup> – Sunday – Today we will head to Croatia and tour Plitvice National Park, this park is one of the best recognized in the world because of its hundreds of waterfalls. You are in for a treat. Tonight, we stay at a local lodge and have a group dinner.

June 9<sup>th</sup> – Monday – We travel deep into Croatia, to the coast and to our residence for the next three days, Dubrovnik. This is a beautiful coastal city.

June 10<sup>th</sup> – Tuesday – Today, the bus will take us to the walled old town of Dubrovnik, where we will meet our guide and tour this amazing city. We will spend most of our day touring.

June 11<sup>th</sup> – Wednesday – We will have a partial free day for you to explore but we are also planning a cruise off the coast in the beautiful Adriatic Sea.

June 12<sup>th</sup> – Thursday – Travel to Mostar in Bosnia and tour the city, see how Bosnia functions. This afternoon we go to Medjugorje, where the famous apparition of the Virgin Mary occurred.

June 13<sup>th</sup> – Friday – We travel back to Croatia on our way to the beautiful seaside city of Zadar. On the way, we will stop for a wine tasting to include snacks.

June 14<sup>th</sup> – Saturday – Today, we travel and tour the beautiful beach city Opatija. We will stay at the fabulous Adriatic Hotel.

June 15<sup>th</sup> – Sunday, on our way back to Venice we will tour the city of Trieste, along the Italian coast. Dinner at the hotel tonight.
