



**Snapshot of Rome Tour
with Florence and Pompei
March 13 – March 21, 2027**

Cost \$2,695 for double occupancy

Single Room (Limited) \$3,395

Includes:

- Transportation, guides, entrance fees to attractions, 10 meals and one hotel for the entire tour
- Rome: Tour the Vatican City which includes St. Peter's Basilica and the Sistine Chapel. Tour the Colosseum and the Pantheon and stop at the Trevi Fountain. Dinner at a special restaurant in Rome
- Tour of Assisi and St. Francis Basilica
- Florence: Tour of the city, the Statue of David, and visit the Ponte Vecchio
- Tour Pompei and visit Naples

Level of Walking: Difficult, especially in Rome and Florence.

Tentative Itinerary:

March 13th – Fly out of United States to Rome's Fiumicino Airport.

March 14th – Arrive in Rome, a Gonzalo host will meet you and get you transferred to your hotel. There will be a meeting in the evening to provide trip information and to meet your hosts and guide.

March 15th – Today will be an introductory tour as we visit the Trevi Fountain, Piazza Navona and the Roman Forum. The day will conclude at the Colosseum, where you will get to see what the life of a Gladiator entailed. Dinner at the hotel is included.

March 16th - Today we enjoy the magic of the Vatican City. We will tour the Vatican Museum, the Sistine Chapel and St. Peter's Basilica. This afternoon, you will have free time to explore.

March 17th – Today we will visit the Catacombs of Rome (ancient underground burial places) which date from the second to the fifth century and were primarily used by Christians and Jews.

March 18th – Full Day to Pompei and Naples. In 79 AD Mount Vesuvius erupted and Pompei a town of approximately 20,000 people was covered by volcanic ash. Many did not have time to evacuate, and homes were covered by the destruction of the volcano. Pompeii has now been excavated, and you can see how the people lived and how the community looked. Following Pompeii, we will tour Naples, a large city in the south of Italy. If time permits, we will stop and have some Naples pizza.

March 19th – Today we head to Tuscany to see the amazing City of Florence. We will visit and tour the Accademia Gallery with the Statue of David, see the Ponte Vecchio and the Duomo, as well as enjoy the beautiful streets of Florence.

March 20th – Today we head to Assisi to see this amazing town created by St. Francis of Assisi, an Italian saint, friar, deacon and priest and founder of the Franciscan Order. Top on our list is the famous St. Francis Basilica. Tonight, we will enjoy a farewell dinner.

March 21st – Transfer to the airport for our flights home to the U.S.
