Tentative Itinerary:

June 16th – Monday – Fly out of United States to Barcelona, Spain.

June 17th – Tuesday – Arrive in Spain – host will meet you at the airport and get you to your hotel.

June 18th – Wednesday - Tour of Monastery of Montserrat and then visit Cava (Champagne) Winery.

June 19th – Thursday – Visit Sagrada Familia Basilica (Gaudi's famous work), bus tour of Barcelona with guide, dinner and Flamenco Show.

June 20th – Friday - Travel day as we head to the "Monte Carlo of Spain", the City of San Sebastian, which is located in the Basque country and borders France. Dinner will be at the hotel.

June 21st – Saturday - Visit the old quarter of San Sebastian and enjoy some of the best tapas in all of Spain.

June 22nd – Sunday - Visit and tour a beautiful winery in Getaria.

June 23rd – Monday - Tour the Guggenheim Museum, and then head to the town of Comillas to see one of Gaudi's famous works, "El Capricho de Gaudi".

June 24th – Tuesday - Visit Asturias to see the famous "Virgin of Covadonga". Then enjoy lunch of Fabada, a typical delicacy of Asturias and shopping. Dinner will be in the village of Valdeon and it will be another of Spain's delicacies, paella.

June 25th – Wednesday – Hike the Royal Gorge, one of the best hiking trails in Spain (for those that have difficulties, we have taxis). Once you arrive, a special lunch of barbequed ribs and chicken will be served. Dinner that evening, will consist of a "Spanish Happy Hour."

June 26th – Thursday – Travel to Leon for a tour of the Leon Cathedral and enjoy a special dinner at a 16th century tavern.

June 27th – Friday - Head to Madrid with a stop in the Valley of the Fallen. Check in and have dinner at the hotel.

June 28th – Saturday – Tour of the Prado Art Museum and the Plaza Mayor.

June 29th – Sunday – Panoramic tour of Madrid and then free time to shop and enjoy Madrid.
