Tentative Itinerary:

June 14th Fly out of United States to Madrid, Spain.

June 15th Arrive in Spain – A Gonzalo host will meet you at the airport and get you to your hotel. There will be a group meeting at the hotel this evening.

- June 16th** Tour of Prado Art Museum, Tour of the Royal Palace. This evening we will tour Plaza Mayor and possibly have some world-famous churros.
- June 17th** Tour of the Valley of the Fallen and a Panoramic Bus Tour of Madrid. Tonight we will have dinner as a group.
- June 18th** Travel day as we head to the “Monte Carlo of Spain,” the City of San Sebastian, which is located in the Basque country and borders France. Dinner at the hotel is included.
- June 19th** Visit the old quarter of San Sebastian and enjoy some of the best tapas in all of Spain. Time to explore the beautiful city and their picturesque beach.
- June 20th** Visit and tour a beautiful winery in Getaria as well as some spectacular scenery and great wine.
- June 21st** Tour the Guggenheim Museum and then head to the town of Comillas to see one of Gaudi’s famous works, “El Capricho de Gaudi.”
- June 22nd** Visit Asturias to see the famous “Virgin of Covadonga.” Then enjoy lunch of Fabada soup, a typical delicacy of Asturias and shopping. Dinner will be in the village of Valdeon and it will be another of Spain’s delicacies, paella.
- June 23rd** Hike the Royal Gorge, one of the best hiking trails in Spain (for those that have difficulties, we have taxis). Once you arrive, a special lunch of barbequed ribs and chicken will be served. Later that evening, dinner will consist of a “Spanish Happy Hour.”
- June 24th** Today we begin our pilgrimage to the beautiful City of Santiago de Compostela. First, however we must stop to partake of a typical pilgrim’s lunch.
- June 25th** This morning, we will meet our guide at the hotel and tour the Cathedral of Santiago de Compostela. This afternoon we will either go to the Pilgrim’s

Mass or to Cape Finisterre, the final stop for the pilgrim's in their journey.

June 26th As we begin our journey back to Madrid, we will stop but in the City of Leon, where you will see the cathedral with the most stained-glass windows in all of Spain. Tonight we have a special dinner at a 16th century tavern.

June 27th On our way back to Madrid we will stop in Segovia to see the famous Aqueduct. Tonight we stay at a hotel near the airport.

June 28th Transfer to airport for flights home
