Tentative Schedule

Friday, May 15th – Fly to Logan Airport in Boston where you will be met by Gonzalo Tour Hosts, who will get you transferred to the Embassy Suites. There will be an orientation meeting in the evening.

Saturday, May 16th - Breakfast – Today, we will tour the main sights of Boston. This will include a walking history tour of the Revolutionary War. You will see Faneuil Hall and the South Meeting Hall. You will hear stories of the Boston Massacre, Boston Tea Party and the Stamp Riot Acts. You'll go through "the North End", which is the Italian Section with a lot of historic history and it is also where you will have lunch.

After lunch you will enjoy a Boston City Harbor Cruise, which will provide you with a different perspective of the city and it will also be great for photo opportunities.

Following the cruise, we will drive north to Andover to the Double Tree by Hilton Hotel where we will be spending the next 5 nights.

We will stop outside the residence of JFK's beloved grandfather and Boston Mayor, John F. Fitzgerald. You will see where JFK proposed to Jackie. There will be a stop where Ted Kennedy and John F. Kennedy both gave key speeches. You will see the Rose Kennedy Greenway (public park) and hear how Senator Edward Kennedy secured the funding for Boston's Big Dig Project. Lunch will be at Quincy Market.

After lunch, we will tour Fenway Park, where the Boston Red Sox play and The Boston Garden, home of the Boston Celtics. We will then return to our hotel in Andover.

Monday, May 18th – Breakfast - Today will be exciting as we will travel to Kennebunkport, Maine for a Hands On, Lobster Boat Tour.

A boat will take you on a tour of the Kennebunk River where you will enjoy the scenic coastline and as a bonus, you can watch the boating crew haul lobster traps. Sit back and relax or roll up your sleeves and help!

Following the boat ride, we will tour the City of Kennebunkport, to include President Bush's compound or summer home, before returning by coastal route to our hotel in Andover.

Tuesday, May 19th – Breakfast – Harvard University will be one of our stops today with a guide explaining the history and tradition of this university.

Following lunch, we will head to Concord and Lexington for a tour of this historical area. You will see Buckman Tavern, Lexington Green and the North Bridge in Concord. Also on the schedule is the Orchard House, home of author Louisa May Alcott. We will also see the Old Manse where Nathaniel Hawthorne and Ralph Waldo Emerson lived. History experienced in a beautiful setting.

Wednesday, May 20th – Breakfast – Travel to Salem, Mass where you will have a bewitching experience as you see and feel the history of this city. You will see the House of the Seven Gables, many "Hawthorne" sights, the famous graveyards and memorials etc.

Following Salem, we will stop at Zorvino Vineyards to celebrate the end of the tour with a wine tasting and snacks before returning to our hotel.
