Tentative Itinerary:

June 19th – Thursday – Fly out of the United States to Oslo, Norway

June 20th – Friday – Arrive at the Oslo Airport and be greeted by one of our hosts who will then get you transferred to the hotel in the center of the city. Meeting that evening to go over trip details.

June 21st – Saturday – Walking tour with a visit to the Opera House and the roof, visit the city library and the Munch Museum to see the most famous painting after the Mona Lisa, The Scream. Afternoon free for some exploring.

June 22nd – Sunday - Bus Tour with guide of the Vigeland Sculpture Park, visit the Holmenkollbakken Ski Jump and the Akershus Castle and Fortress with the WW II Resistance Museum.

June 23rd – Monday – Go to Lillehammer, sight of the 1994 Winter Olympics, see the Olympic venues and then the Maihaugen Open Air Museum. Tonight, we stay in lodge high up in the mountains. Dinner included

June 24th – Tuesday – Drive through the beautiful Gudbrandsdalen Valley on our way to the see Alesund, the Art Nouveau Center where we will have a guided tour. Dinner at the hotel.

June 25th – Wednesday – Today we take a cruise through the World Heritage Geirangerfjord, where you will see some of the most spectacular scenery in Norway. Tonight, we stay in Loen at the Hotel Alexandra, where they have great food.

June 26th – Thursday – Today we visit Briksdal Glacier, where we will take electric cars up to the glacier. Again, dinner will be at the hotel Alexandra.

June 27th – Friday – Today we take our second spectacular cruise along the Naeroyfjord. This is highly rated by UNESCO and we will end up in the second largest city in Norway, Bergen.

June 28th – Saturday – Today we tour the beautiful city of Bergen including the old German Quarters, the fish market and the Mount Floyen and the Funicular.

June 29th - Sunday – Visit to a small farming community to see how Norway farms operate. We'll stop at an apple farm for some snacks and apple cider. In the evening, we stay in the small community of Rauland. Dinner will be at the hotel.

June 30th – Monday – Tour of Vemork, where the Nazis tried to produce heavy water to use for their Atomic Bombs. The movie, "Heroes of Telemark" depicted this situation. A visit to Heddal Stave Church in Telemark, before going to our hotel at the airport.

July 1st – Tuesday – Transfer to our flights to go home.
