- Bosnia: Tour of Medjugorje and see where the famous apparition occurred, tour of the old section of Mostar, wine tasting in Zadar.

Level of Walking: – Moderate: This trip consists of stairs, inclines, unlevel streets and city walks.

Tentative Itinerary:

Friday, May 29th – Depart from the United States to the Marco Polo Airport in Venice, Italy.

Saturday, May 30th – Arrive in Venice, a host will meet you and get you to your hotel. There will be a meeting in the evening to provide information and you can meet your hosts, guide and the other guests.

Sunday, May 31st – Take the train into Venice and then a boat to St. Mark's Square. You will tour the city with a guide which will include St. Mark's Square and the Murano Glass Factory. The day will conclude with a ride in a world famous gondola on a Venice canal.

Monday, June 1st – Leave Venice and head to Ljubljana to begin our tour of the beautiful country of Slovenia. Our first tour will be of the awesome caves of Postojna followed by the famous Predjama Castle. We will stay at the Intercontinental Hotel in Ljubljana.

Tuesday, June 2nd – A local guide will take us on a walking tour of the beautiful city of Ljubljana and then to Lake Bled. At Lake Bled we will enjoy a boat tour which will take us to visit the beautiful church and then “row” over to the former leader of Yugoslavia’s residence.

Wednesday, June 3rd – Today we will head to Croatia and tour Plitvice National Park, this park is one of the best recognized in the world because of its hundreds of waterfalls. You are in for a treat. Tonight, we stay at a local hotel, the Lyra and have a group dinner.

Thursday, June 4th – We travel deep into Croatia, to the coast and to our residence for the next three days, Dubrovnik. This is a beautiful coastal city. We will stay at Hotel Lapad for 3 nights.

Friday, June 5th – Today, the bus will take us to the walled old town of Dubrovnik, where we will meet our guide and take a walking tour.

Saturday, June 6th – We will have a partial free day for you to explore but we are also planning a cruise off the coast in the beautiful Adriatic Sea.

Sunday, June 7th – Travel to Mostar in Bosnia and tour the city, see how Bosnia functions. This afternoon we go to Medjugorje, where the famous apparition of the Virgin Mary occurred. Our hotel is the Hotel Luna in Medjugorje.

Monday, June 8th – We travel back to Croatia on our way to the beautiful seaside city of Zadar. On the way, we will stop for a wine tasting to include snacks.

June 9th – Tuesday – Today, we travel and tour the beautiful beach city, Opatija. We will stay at the fabulous Adriatic Hotel where dinner is included.

Wednesday, June 10th – On our way back to Venice we will stop in the City of Trieste, along the Italian coast. Dinner tonight at the Antony Palace Hotel in Mestre.

Thursday, June 11th – Transfer to airport for our flights home.
