- Killarney: Tour of the Dingle Peninsula, the Famous Ring of Kerry, Muckross House, ride jaunting carts through Killarney National Park,
- Tour the Midleton Distillery and visit the National Stud & Gardens

Tentative Itinerary:

June 30th – Fly out of the United States to Dublin, Ireland.

July 1st - Arrive in Dublin, and a Gonzalo Tours host will meet you and provide transportation to the hotel. There will be a meeting in the evening.

July 2nd - Tour of Kilmainham Gaol Museum, St. Patrick's Cathedral and Dublin. Tonight, dinner and a show will be at the Merry Ploughboys Pub.

July 3rd - Depart for Northern Ireland and Belfast

The history will be explained so that you understand why the Protestant and Catholics live in separate areas and you will tour these areas. The afternoon will be spent at the Titanic Museum.

July 4th - We head to the tip of the island for to one of the top wonders of the world, Giant's Causeway. Afternoon excursion to Stormont Castle with a tour of the City of Belfast.

July 5th - Across the island we go towards the college town of Galway, it has great pubs, Irish Music and restaurants. We will stop at the North Atlantic Sheepdog headquarters and watch how sheep dogs control their flocks.

July 6th - Today we travel through Connemara National Park. We will visit the picturesque Kylemore Abbey and its gardens.

July 7th - This afternoon we are off to the world-famous Cliffs of Moher. In the evening, we will visit a medieval castle where we will also enjoy dinner and a show.

July 8th - We head to the Dingle Peninsula, but not before making a stop at the beautiful little town of thatched roofs, Adare. On to Dingle, to see the beauty along the famous Sleat Head Drive. Dinner at our hotel tonight in Killarney.

July 9th - Today we start our free day with a tour of Killarney National Park on jaunting carts. The rest of the day is yours, you can shop, venture into the many pubs, bicycle ride, hike, play golf, you choose, it's your day!

July 10th - Today we start with a brief visit to the Muckross House and its beautiful location on Killarney Lake. Next, we jump on the Ring of Kerry, with our first stop at the Red Fox Inn to enjoy traditional Irish coffee. The Ring is the number one scenic drive in Ireland, as you will see. We will stop at an scenic overlook restaurant for lunch.

July 11th - On our way back to Dublin we will make a few stops. The first will be at the Midleton Distillery for a tour and tasting as well as time for lunch. The second stop will be to tour the Irish National Stud & Gardens. We will end the day at the airport hotel.

July 12th - Shuttles run regularly to the airport for you trip back to the U.S.
