Tentative Itinerary:

June 29th – Fly from the United States to Lisbon, Portugal.

June 30th – Arrive at the airport in Lisbon and a Gonzalo host will meet you and get you transferred to the HF Fenix Lisboa Hotel. This will be your home for the next 5 nights. There will be a meeting in the evening to go over the trip and so that you can meet your hosts.

July 1st – Tour the intriguing City of Lisbon with a guide. We will see sights such as: the Belem Tower, Jeronimos Monastery, the Alfama area (where the fisherman lived), and the elevators that got the Portuguese from one part of the city to the other. Enjoy the famous pastries of Belem.

July 2nd – Today we tour Sintra National Palace, followed by a tour of Cascais, a beach holiday destination and Cabo da Roca, the most westerly point of mainland Europe.

July 3rd – Today we explore Fatima and learn about the apparitions, that occurred in 1917. Lunch will be along the Atlantic in the fishing/surfing village of Nazare.

July 4th – Free day to explore. This evening we will take a wine and snack river cruise on the Tagus River.

July 5th - We travel today to Santiago de Compostela in Spain. This is on the route where pilgrims travel to honor St. James. Dinner at the hotel.

July 6th – Tour of the famous Cathedral of Santiago de Compostela, where pilgrims travel hundreds of miles to honor St. James. You will have the option to attend a pilgrim's mass.

July 7th – Morning trek to Finisterre, Spain also known as the end of the world. Next, we will travel along the beautiful coast to the second largest city in Portugal, Porto. Here we will tour the city with a guide and then proceed to our hotel for dinner.

July 8th – Be ready for pure beauty as we will travel to see the vineyards in the Douro Valley and have a fabulous lunch too. Of course there will be a wine tasting.

July 9th – Just like Italy, Portugal has its own Venice and today we will visit Aveiro and its canals.

July 10th – Visit the quaint medieval town of Obidos where you can do some last - minute shopping. We will then return to Lisbon to prepare for our flights home.

July 11th – Transfer to the airport for our flights home.
