Tentative Itinerary:

April 3rd – Thursday – Fly from the United States to Lisbon, Portugal.

April 4th – Friday – Arrive at the airport in Lisbon and a host will meet you and get you transferred to the Porto Bay Marques Hotel. This will be your home for the next 5 nights. Meeting at 8:00pm

April 5th – Saturday – Tour of the intriguing city of Lisbon with a guide. We will see sights such as: the Belem Tower, Jeronimos Monastery, the Alfama area (where the fisherman lived), and the elevators that get you from one part of the city to another.

April 6th – Sunday – Tour of the Sintra National Palace and then spend some time in the beautiful coastal city of Cascais.

April 7th – Monday – Tour of Fatima and learn about the apparition, visit the quaint town of Obidos. Lunch at the ocean in Nazare.

April 8th – Tuesday - Visit a cork farm where you will see how cork is produced and all its functions.

April 9th- Wednesday - We begin our travel to Santiago de Compostela in Spain. This is on the route where pilgrims travel to honor St. James. Dinner at the hotel.

April 10th – Thursday – Tour of the famous Cathedral of Santiago de Compostela, where pilgrims travel hundreds of miles to honor St. James. We will *try* to attend the pilgrim's mass.

April 11th – Friday – Travel along the beautiful coast to the second largest city in Portugal, O'Porto. This afternoon we will tour O'Porto with a guide and then proceed to our hotel for dinner.

April 12th – Saturday – Today we will tour and have lunch in the Duoro Valley. This beautiful valley with its wine vineyards is fabulous and the wine is too!

April 13th – Sunday – Just like Italy, Portugal has its own Venice, and today we will visit Aveiro and its canals. We will tour the city on its canals and streets.

April 14th – Monday - We will head to the to the famous college town of Coimbra for a tour. We will then return to Lisbon to get ready for our flights home.

April 15th – Tuesday - Transfer to the airport for our flights home.
