Tentative Itinerary:

Thursday, October 9th: Fly out of the United States to London Heathrow Airport.

Friday, October 10th: Arrive at Heathrow Airport and you will be met by your host and transferred to the hotel. Meeting in the evening to discuss last minute trip details.

Saturday, October 11th: Tour of London including the Changing of the Guard before going to the hotel (located in central London). Dinner cruise on the Thames River.

Sunday, October 12th: Tour of Churchill's War Rooms and Westminster Abbey

Monday, October 13th: Tour of Windsor Castle and a stop at Stonehenge before arriving at the old Roman town of Bath for the night.

Tuesday, October 14th: Short tour of Bath, then a tour of Oxford. We will then head to our hotel in Cardiff, where we will stay for three nights.

Wednesday, October 15th: Today will consist of short tour outside of Cardiff, at Tintern Abbey (12th Century) and Chepstow Castle (the oldest post Roman stone fortification). The afternoon will be spent in Abergavenny, a quaint Welsh town with a lot of shops and eateries.

Thursday, October 16th: We will explore Cardiff today, including Cardiff Castle before going to Glyndwr Vineyard to see how the wine is made and of course do a little wine tasting.

Friday, October 17th: Today, we head to Chester but not before making a stop at Brecon Beacons National Park to visit the National Showcaves Centre of Wales. We will then head to Chester, which is an intriguing walled city, this will be home for three nights.

Saturday, October 18th: Off to Conwy, where we will see the old suspension bridge and toll house. You'll be able to cross the bridge. Then on to Conwy Castle, the old medieval castle built in 1287. From there, we will go to Snowdonia where we will take the train to the top of the mountain. Beautiful spectacular scenery.

Sunday, October 19th: Today we head to Liverpool to tour by bus, the city that was made famous by the Beatles. We'll see all the sights associated with them. We'll also take the Mersey River Cruise and visit the Beatle's Story.

Monday, October 20th: Explore the City of Chester where you can walk the walls that surround the city. Then we head back to London via the Cotswolds. That evening will conclude at the airport hotel.

Tuesday, October 21st: Transfer to the airport for our return to the U.S.
