June 26th - Friday - Fly from the United States to Lisbon, Portugal.

June 27th – Saturday – Arrive at the airport in Lisbon and a host will meet you and get you transferred to the HF Fenix Lisboa Hotel. This will be your home for the next 5 nights. Meeting in the evening.
