Tuesday, June 16th Fly out of United States to Madrid, Spain.

Wednesday, June 17th Arrive in Spain
Gonzalo Tour hosts will meet you at the airport and get you to your hotel. Group meeting at hotel this evening.

Thursday, June 18th
Tour of Prado Art Museum, Tour of the Royal Palace. Evening tour of Plaza Mayor and enjoy some world-famous churros.

Saturday, June 20th

Monday, June 22nd

Visit and tour a beautiful winery in Getaria. Some spectacular scenery and some great wine.

Tuesday, June 23rd

Tour the Guggenheim Museum, and then head to the town of Comillas to see one of Gaudi’s famous works, “El Capricho de Gaudi”. Our stay today is in the province of Santander.

Wednesday, June 24th

Visit Asturias to see the famous “Virgin of Covadonga”. Then enjoy lunch of Fabada, a typical delicacy of Asturias and shopping. Dinner will be in the village of Valdeon and it will be another of Spain’s delicacies, paella.

Thursday, June 25th

Hike the Royal Gorge, one of the best hiking trails in Spain (for those that have difficulties, we have taxis). Once you arrive, a special lunch of barbequed ribs and chicken will be served. Dinner that evening, will consist of a “Spanish Happy Hour.”

Friday, June 26th

Today we begin our pilgrimage to the beautiful city of Santiago de Compostela. First however we must stop along the way to partake of a typical pilgrim’s lunch.

Saturday, June 27th

Meet our guide at the hotel and do our tour of the Cathedral of Santiago de Compostela. This afternoon we will either go to the Pilgrim’s Mass or go to Finisterre, the final stop for pilgrims in their journey.

Sunday, June 28th

Begin our journey back to Madrid but not without a stop in the city of Leon, where you will see the Cathedral with the most stain glass windows in all of Spain.

Tonight we have a special dinner at a 16th century tavern.

Monday, June 29th

Travel back to Madrid but only with a stop in Segovia to see the famous Aqueduct. Tonight we stay near the airport.
